Megan D'Orvilliers: President's Welcome

Dear Bay Soccer Families,

On behalf of the Bay Soccer Club and its Board of Directors, I would like to welcome you to the 2009 Spring Soccer Season! There's so much that goes into keeping Bay Soccer sailing smooth here on the shores of Lake Erie that I thought to provide a little background for your consideration.

The Bay Soccer Club is a not-for-profit organization that works closely with the City of Bay Village to provide organized soccer to the youth of our community. The club has been in existence for over 30 years and is one of the largest organizations in the city; this year the club serves over 1,200 youth soccer players, plus their parents and families, referees and coaches. A seventeen member Board of Directors, all volunteers, manages the club. Each member serves a one-year term (no term limits) with elections held each year in October.

Bay Soccer Club manages three main programs during the year. These are:

Recreational Soccer (In -House Soccer Program) – This Spring, we are pleased to have over 1,200 children, ranging in age from three to eighteen, coming out to play soccer at Cahoon Park each Saturday. This group comprises over 130 teams. With a program of this magnitude, we rely on the volunteer efforts of over 250 head and assistant coaches to get our season off the ground. We are grateful for the time and energy these individuals share with our children. Additionally, about 80 student referees serve the club to provide order on our fields. Please remember that this program is a developmental ground for these referees, as well as the players. Have patience with these young adults; they are our kids, too. Referee abuse will NOT be tolerated.

Competitive Soccer (Travel Soccer Program) – Bay Soccer Club currently fields over 35 travel teams (as well as a handful of U8 developmental teams) which compete in both the Fall and the Spring in either the Northern Ohio Girls Soccer League (NOGSL) for the girls or the American Amateur Soccer League (AASL) for the boys. These teams play other, similarly organized teams from communities within northern Ohio. There are nearly 450 players in this program. Most of these children got their start playing in our recreational program at three and four years of age. Over 60 state-licensed coaches contribute to the development of these teams. BSC's travel program has, over the years, produced many fine teams and players, and serves as a feeder for Bay's superior high school soccer programs.

Bay Challenge Cup Tournament – It has been a tradition since the first days of the club to host a competitive Labor Day Weekend soccer tournament each year. Since the first tournament back in 1978, the Bay Challenge Cup has grown in size and in stature within the soccer community. As the main fundraiser for Bay Soccer Club, the Challenge Cup relies totally on the hard work and tremendous dedication of volunteers. This work has paid off in the form of the tournament's great reputation, as well as the proceeds which primarily fund the training and development of our travel teams.

I would be remiss if I did not take a line to express my personal, gigantic, encompassing THANK YOU to all the aforementioned board members and coaches, parents, students and friends for your support of Bay Soccer Club. It is a privilege to serve you and your children. It brings me great pleasure to come out each week and see our kids join together in fun, competition and friendship through the sport of soccer.

Sean Egan: Director of Referees

It's official! The 2009 season has arrived and we are all very excited to get started...

We have recruited and trained over 70 young referees to officiate your son's and daughter's games this spring and we are counting on you, the parents, players and coaches to help them have a FUN and successful season.

The role that parents and coaches play in the life of a young soccer player has a tremendous impact on their experience. Same can be said for the lives of our young referees...

Please keep in mind the relative youth and inexperience of some of our referees. Let's not say or do anything which might discourage these kids from continuing as referees. We ask that you do your best to understand and display appropriate game behavior at all times as ultimately our children's self esteem and game performance is at stake. Be supportive, cheer and be appropriate.

We also completely understand that soccer games are as exciting for some parents and coaches as they are for their children. They want to support the team, cheer for the team, and encourage their child. However, on occasion, their enthusiasm combined with a lack of familiarity with the game may cause problems. We do not want to curb anyone's enthusiasm for the game. We simply want to make sure that the enthusiasm is channeled in a way in which will be helpful and complies with the rules of the game. In this spirit, please keep these suggestions in mind as you attend Bay Soccer Club recreation soccer games:

1. **DO NOT YELL AT THE REFEREE:** It is our goal to build not only good soccer players and referees but good sportsmen and sportswomen. Collectively our positive, or negative, example at games will either greatly reinforce or significantly undermine that effort. Our referees have been instructed to not tolerate any abusive behavior. They will not hesitate in stopping a game to locate a Bay Soccer Club board member, for help, if needed.
2. **KNOW THE RULES OF THE GAME:** Sometimes ill-will toward a referee is based upon one's ignorance to the rules of the game. To become a better informed supporter please refer to the abbreviated list of our most important rules on the following pages or for a complete listing of the rules of the game please log onto <http://ussoccer.com/laws/index.jsp.html>
3. **ENCOURAGE - DO NOT CRITICIZE:** One of our goals is to help your children and our referees to have fun and enjoy their soccer experience. We can all do our part by confining our talk during the game to positive encouragement.

Please keep in mind that the younger age groups are still trying to learn the rules of the game. As a result, our referees have been instructed to use rule violations presented during the game as teaching opportunities.

Finally, let's all try to keep soccer in its proper perspective. Soccer should not be larger than life for any of us. The goals of youth recreation soccer are simple: for the kids to have fun, to be safe, to build character and, most important, to learn sportsmanship and fair play.

Thank you all for your kind support. I look forward to a fun and safe season.

2009 Bay Soccer Club In-House Rules

The Kids are Our First Priority

The Bay Soccer Club Recreational In-House program is to be enjoyed by everyone including Moms, Dads, Aunts, Uncles, Grandparents, Coaches, the Student Referees and most importantly, the Players. Please be sure the kids playing and refereeing are always treated fairly and with respect. **This program is all about the kids.**

Registration

The Bay Soccer Club rules, as well as our insurance policy, prohibit the participation of any unregistered/non-rostered players. It will be the coach's responsibility to play only eligible players. Rosters may be reviewed at any time during the season and violations may result in the forfeiture of games.

Open "walk-in" Registration takes place early in January with "mail-ins" being allowed through January 31st. Late registration received February 1st or later will incur a \$20 late fee with no exception. Registration may be closed at any time after the deadline after a division has been filled.

Equipment

All players must wear shin guards, their jersey, and athletic or soccer shoes. Shoes must remain tied. The goalie must wear a different color jersey from the rest of their team. A substitute jersey of a similar color will only be acceptable if approved by the referee. No players shall, during any game, wear jewelry, such as, necklaces, earrings, studs, rings, bracelets, barrettes (hard plastic or metal), watches, etc. All casts or other foreign objects must be inspected and approved by the referee and/or the In-House Commissioner, Director of Referees or President prior to the start of the game. **Note: Medical ID and Religious bracelets or necklaces are permitted if taped to the player to avoid injury to themselves or fellow players.**

Playing Time

All players must be afforded an equal amount of participation unless there is a specific request for less. All rostered players should participate or play a minimum of one half (1/2) but no one player should play more than three fourths (3/4) of any game unless the team is without an adequate number of substitutes. Players should be encouraged to try all positions. No one player should take all throw-ins, goal, corner or penalty kicks.

Ball Size

The Home Team will provide the game ball. Ball Sizes are as follows:

- #3 for U4-5 (Pre-School),
- #4 for U6 through U11 (K-5th)
- #5 for Jr. High Co-ed and Older (6-12th grade)

All teams must "play down" when there are insufficient players present at game time. If players are late, a game start may only be delayed 5 minutes with the consent of both coaches. The referee will also reduce the half time interval in accordance to playing time lost. When players arrive late they may be added to the field, equally, at any regular stoppage of play, with the permission of the referee. The referee must be notified that the "late player" has arrived, and have an opportunity to check equipment before the player may enter the game.

Player count may be reduced as follows:

7 V 7 may be reduced to 4 V 4, prior to a forfeit.

6 V 6 may be reduced to 4 V 4, prior to a forfeit.

4 V 4 may be reduced to 3 V 3, prior to a forfeit.

The In-House Commissioner, President or Director of Referees must approve all other reductions.

Once a reduced game has started without substitutes, an injury to one player will not result in an automatic forfeit. However, any additional reductions may result in a forfeit. In a reduced game, a team will play disadvantaged. The 4 goal differential rule, discussed later, will apply, but only to a team that has available players to be added. If any game has been forfeited, coaches should amicably adjust teams and scrimmage. All regular season games will be played or forfeited and not rescheduled because of insufficient players.

Four Goal Differential

For all teams, U6 and older, there remains the 4 goal differential rule which applies to only regular season games and states that once a team's score exceeds their opponent's score by 4 or more goals, the leading team must play with at least one less player than their opponent's team. It is recommended that the team behind add an additional player to the field to achieve this

differential. The coach behind in goals will be asked by the referee to determine whether he/she will add a player to the field otherwise the leading team may have to remove a player. This adjustment will remain in effect until the score differential is reduced to less than 4 goals. Further adjustments are not required and may only be initiated by the leading team. It is encouraged that with each successive goal by the leading team, an additional player should be added to the team behind. If the teams have already been downsized because of insufficient players, the team behind should always add a player, when possible, until the goal differential is reduced to less than 4 goals. Remember, this rule for reduction may not produce or result in a forfeit.

Rules Specific to Age

Pre-K to K: No Goalkeepers

Both teams may substitute players on any play stoppage.

U7 and Younger

One retake for a bad throw-in is permitted.

No yellow or red cards for players. Coaches may be carded.

Retake or modification of goal kicks with the ball moved out of the goal box may be decided by the referee.

U8 and Older

All FIFA rules apply; except NO Slide Tackles. The BSC issues a yellow card (first offense) or red card (second offense) and an indirect free kick for slide tackles.

Coaches can be carded, red or yellow, at all levels and age groups.

A player who receives a red card will be required to leave the remainder of that game and his/her team will continue play with one less player than their opponent's team. He/she may be permitted to play the following week unless they have received two (2) red cards in the season or the Director of Referees deems that player ineligible to play. In the Director of Referees absence, the In-House Commissioner will make this decision. All red cards will be reviewed by the Director of Referees and In-House Commissioner at the conclusion of game day. This action cannot produce or result in a forfeit.

U10 and Older

Offsides will be enforced.

U-9 and younger may not purposely "station" a player near the goal. After a warning, an infraction may result in an indirect free kick. The ruling will be at the referee's sole discretion and not questioned by the coaches or guests watching the match.

Co-ed (Junior & Senior)

All teams are co-ed

Co-ed Players should be given equal playing time and shared field positions. A proportional co-ed makeup of players should be on the field at all times. Additional rules and concerns may be addressed and forthcoming.

Each player is allowed a maximum of three (3 goals in a given game). There is no limit to the number of assists a player may earn. During playoffs, the 3 goal maximum will be in effect through the end of overtime but waived during a shootout.

Due to the busy schedule of High School players and in the interest of keeping the Rec experience fun, the High School Division teams will have larger rosters than traditional In-House teams. Coaches should prepare to play 11 v 11 however they should expect to play as few as 6 v 6. The appropriate number of players for each game should be determined prior to the start of the match by both coaches and the referee; and if necessary, the In-House Commissioner. If additional players arrive after the match, both coaches can agree to increase numbers with the referee's permission.

Standings

STANDINGS: The Division standings, leading to the playoff and championship games, will be determined by applying each of the following criteria, in order, until any ties in the standings can be broken:

- a. Calculate the following totals for each team: 3 points for each win, 1 point for each tie, 0 points for each loss.
- b. Head to head wins. (Among tied teams if all teams have games in common)
- c. Total goals given up, to date, ranked from fewest goals given up to most; if 2 or more teams remain tied continue to step d.
- d. Total goals scored, to date, ranked from most goals scored to least, and counting at most four for any one game (to discourage running up the score). If still tied, continue to step e.
- e. Coin flip. This action will only be taken at the end of the regular season by a committee designated by the In-House Commissioner, who will also determine the place and time of this action.

Playoffs: Rules and Variations

During the playoff and championship games, there will be no (4) goal differential rule. All teams will continue to play, at full strength, without regard to goals scored. (HS teams will still have an option to play as low as 6 v 6 if numbers are low). If at the end of regulation time in a playoff match, the score is tied, the following procedure will be implemented in the exact order presented until a step in the procedure is reached at which point the outcome is decided:

- a. Two full five-minute overtime periods will be played. Between the two periods, the teams will switch ends. Regardless of whether or not either or both teams score at any point in either overtime period, both five minute overtime periods will be played in full. Coaches are expected to play each and all of their players at least five of the ten overtime minutes.
- b. Penalty Kicks. The referee will toss a coin, to be called heads or tails by the visiting captain. The winner of the coin toss will decide whether his/her team will shoot first or second. ALL players from both teams will take one PK each so that each will have the thrill of participating in the PK session. However, if one team has fewer players than the other does, the referee with the help from both coaches will randomly select (such as drawing numbers from a hat) an appropriate number of players to shoot twice from the team with fewer players. Regardless of the differential, every player should have an opportunity to take a PK.
- b. If both teams remain tied, repeat “step b” above in full.
- c. If teams remain tied after step c, continue to repeat step b in full until the tie is broken.

Since this is a recreational league, designed for the enjoyment of our kids, the playoff structure is set up differently from “standard” formats. In the standard format, the first playoff game would feature the first-place team and the last place team, the second place team and the next-to-last team, etc... Based on experience, this format can often lead to final games which do not represent the spirit or mission of the Bay Soccer Club. For example, the last-place team may go winless during the regular season then under the old system, face the first-place team, usually resulting in a lopsided loss to end the spring soccer experience. In 2005 we experimented with a system in which up to eight teams made the playoffs. The first game of the playoffs still matched teams with similar records. However, the second and third games looked more like a typical playoff structure. This proved to be very successful allowing some teams to win their first game of the season and others to advance a bit further than a normal playoff structure might allow.

The BSC playoff structure for six-, eight-, and ten-team divisions follows:

Six teams:

Quarter-finals: 3rd vs. 4th, 5th vs. 6th

Semi-finals: 1st vs. Winner of 5th vs. 6th, 2nd vs. Winner of 3rd vs. 4th

Final: Semi-final winners

Eight teams:

Quarter-finals: 7th vs. 8th, 5th vs. 6th, 1st vs. 4th, 2nd vs. 3rd

Semi-finals: Winner of 2nd/3rd vs. Winner of 7th/8th, Winner of 1st/4th vs. Winner of 5th/6th

Final: Semi-final winners

Ten teams:

Bonus game: 9th vs. 10th (last match of the season for both)

Quarter-finals: 7th vs. 8th, 5th vs. 6th, 1st vs. 4th, 2nd vs. 3rd

Semi-finals: Winner of 2nd/3rd vs. Winner of 7th/8th, Winner of 1st/4th vs. Winner of 5th/6th

Final: Semi-final winners

Game Cards

Coaches **MUST** complete their game cards prior to the start of the game. Do not ask a student referee to complete this for you. **Hint: Complete all cards prior to the season and store them in the coach's bag.** All player's names and numbers must be on the game card. Only rostered players may participate in the game. Your name and your team number must appear in the correct space. The home team will supply the game ball. Verify the game date and game number (the game number is not your team's 1st or 2nd or 3rd game but the league's official game number). Verify the field number. Give the completed game card to the referee prior to the start of your game. Finally, remember the coach must sign the card at the conclusion of the game. Failure to sign will preclude a request to correct a standing dispute.

Rescheduling Games

Coaches may not reschedule or cancel any games. In the case of a "rain-out" or other BSC cancellation, the coach will be notified of the rescheduled game date and time within 48 hours. If there is no notification of the rescheduled date, within this time period, it will be the responsibility of the coach to contact the Club for more information. Coaches will then have the responsibility to contact all rostered players.

In the case of the championship game, if the in-house team has rostered players, who will be playing for their travel team in a tournament and there are insufficient remaining in-house players to field a team, the scheduled championship game may be reviewed, by the club President, the In-House Commissioner and the Director of Referees for possible consideration to be rescheduled. This review will only be considered if the request is submitted, in writing, to the In-House Commissioner, on or before May 10, 2009. There are no exceptions. **Reminder: Parents and players should also be responsible for communicating Travel Team and Premier conflicts to their In-House coach.**

Coach and Spectator Viewing Areas

All coaches and parents must remain off the soccer field while the game is being played. Some latitude is given for the Pre-K (U4 and U5) divisions in an effort to allow the coach to teach the game. No parents or coaches should be on the field during a Kindergarten or older match.

Parents should remain on the opposite sideline from the team during the game. Coaches should remain in their half of the sideline and respect their opponents "team space". Further, remember spectators, parents or teams should not stand behind the goals during the game. The referee may ask the coach to control the players and the parents, otherwise, a red or yellow card may be issued to the coach. If problems persist, the game may be terminated.

Additional Rules, Clarifications and Guidelines

- a. In addition to normal or regular goals scored, a goal may be scored from a kick off or any direct kick. This should not be confused with the indirect kick, which still requires a second player to touch the ball prior to scoring.
- b. A ball is not out of bounds until the entire ball has crossed the touch or goal line.
- c. A goal is not scored or counted until the entire ball crosses the goal plane.

Inclement Weather

In the case of inclement weather, every effort will be made to play. In some cases a delay may be necessary to prevent the cancellation of a game. After a club official has delayed a game, it will be the responsibility of the coach to find out whether the game is rescheduled or canceled. If a delayed game cannot be resumed because the team behind is not available, the score at the time of play stoppage will become the final score. If a game can not be resumed because the team ahead (or tied) is not available, the match will result in a forfeit by the missing team and the opponent will be awarded a 4-0 win. Once the second half of a game has begun, it will be recorded, as a complete game should the match not resume. This rule includes all matches, including playoffs.

Always remember that this program is for our community's youth. We should set a good example of sportsmanship and fair play at all times.

U8 PLAYER DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAM:

A soccer player's development is a continuous process from the first time he or she touches a ball until the time they retire as a player. When successful coaches devise their coaching program, they focus their attention on developing their player's sound technical skills and tactical insight, and their ability to solve the problems, which their players are confronted during soccer games, rather than the result of the match. At the younger ages, developing player's technical skills (such as dribbling, trapping, passing etc.) have proven to be the cornerstone for a player's success and advancement in soccer.

The U8 Developmental Program has been specifically created to focus attention on correct techniques used by players entering the 2nd grade and eligible for U8 Travel. Player's are able to begin their process of building their necessary foot skills and confidence to maintain control of a soccer ball through repetition & positive encouragement. The training program is a disciplined, structured program for those players committed to learning skill techniques over a three month period in the winter. The first component is the foot skill sessions, which are held weekly (typically lasting 1-hour). During the winter from the first weekend in December to the middle of February, players are trained on various techniques involving dribbling, receiving, passing, ball movement, and shooting. Since repetition is critical younger age level, the pace of the training is monitored and adjusted based on the group's ability to successfully perform the techniques. Since this is a learning process, the expectations for results are not immediate, yet, over-time the training results are impressive.

The Development Program will run from the November thru the middle of March. The players will meet on Sundays for one hour. We will spend the first ½ hour on individual skill training, and in the second ½ we will play small-sided games. No scores will be kept for these games and teams will be divided differently each week. This will help in the deemphasize winning at all costs and, players will feel comfortable in taking risks and trying new moves in the small-sided games. The score at the end of the game will not be the measure of the player's success because nothing will be recorded players will hopefully be willing to try a new move or play a different position. Because we never know from where the next Mike Jelenic, Brad Friedel, Judy Aschenbrener, or Karen Winslow will come. From the developmental program the Boys will be divided in teams for the Spring Travel program in the U-8 division and the Girls will play in the In House or Recreation league until the following fall when they will be placed on a travel team. Families that have committed themselves to the development program and to training have witnessed tremendous improvement over the course of the developmental program. In simple terms the program prepares players for the next level. IMPORTANT MESSAGE

The Bay Soccer Club is acutely aware of the parking arrangements at Cahoon Park. There is congestion on game days, especially between games. However, if we all cooperate we can hopefully minimize some of the confusion while maintaining a high degree of safety.

NO PARKING ON LAKE ROAD: The soccer board is requesting NO ONE PARK on the North side of Lake Road, formerly the Bay Gun Club property. We consider attempting to cross Lake Road a very dangerous practice just to access the soccer fields. We hope no one initiates this practice and thereby encouraging others to follow.

NO PARKING ON CAHOON ROAD: No one should ever park their vehicle on either side of Cahoon Road. No parking signs are posted and the Bay Village Police will take appropriate measures at the owner's expense.

PARK AT SOCCER FIELDS: There is ample parking available within the adjacent lot to the soccer fields.

NO PARKING AT EMERGENCY VEHICLE ENTRY POINTS: There are (2) two points of entry, within the park, breaks within the split rail wooden fence where no parking should also be observed. These entry points represent access routes, onto the playing fields, for emergency vehicles. Parking within these designated areas will also result in the action being taken at the owner's expense.

OVERFLOW PARKING AT COMMUNITY HOUSE: When necessary, overflow parking is in the lot East of Cahoon Road at the Community House. Please remember that you are crossing a busy street.

Travel Soccer

As we enter into this spring's season, the Bay Soccer Club Travel Program continues to provide an opportunity for young people to learn and enjoy competitive soccer. Many of our teams are very successful, competing in league play, tournaments and indoor competition. We take pride in the number of our players who have passed through this program and have gone on to contribute at the high school, college and professional levels. Our own Bay High School soccer teams have maintained a level of excellence due in part to the success of the travel program and the dedication of our travel team coaches. With the active support of coaches, families and BSC board members, our players are provided an opportunity to grow and develop both as teammates and as young adults.

Bay Travel Soccer program is for the player who wants to be involved in the game beyond the recreational level. Travel soccer is the next rung of the competitive ladder. In Travel Soccer the level of play is more competitive, training is more advanced, and required commitment from players and their families is greater. It involves playing other community teams within either the Northern Ohio Girls' Soccer League (NOGSL) or the boy's American Amateur Soccer League (AASL). Players are trained to learn fundamental footskills, tactical, and competitive aspects of the game. Coaches, most often chosen from our community, hold coaching licenses, and strive to instill a more complete understanding of soccer, both physically and mentally.

Each year, Bay fields 25-30 teams representing over 300 registered players. New teams are formed during the May-June timeframe, using open tryouts conducted on our area fields. Each prospective player **MUST** go through the tryout process. When teams of players are formed, they stay together for both the upcoming fall and following spring season, competing in league play, tournaments and often as indoor teams.

Tryout times and birth years will be posted on the Bay Soccer web site; www.baysoccer.org There you will find the schedule, age brackets, and forms for this year's tryout program. Check this site often, as schedules may change due to weather or other scheduling conflicts. It is important to note that players should play on the team of his/her grade year or in the age bracket set by the BSC. In the case where a player's current school grade does not coincide with their age bracket, the player will be given the option to try out along with their current school grade so long as it is consistent with league age requirements. Generally, players can play in an older birth year but not play in a younger birth year even though they may be in the same school year as the younger age group. Players try out for only one age group for the upcoming season.

Players in all age groups interested in playing travel soccer should fill out a registration form and bring it to tryouts.
